THE HOSPITAL SERVICES COMMISSION AMENDMENT ACT, 1975

(Assented to , 1975)

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Hospital Services Commission Act is hereby amended.

2. Section 2 is amended

- (a) as to subsection (2), clauses (c), (d) and (e) by striking out the word "Minister" and by substituting the words "Lieutenant Governor in Council",
- (b) by striking out subsection (6).

3. Section 3, subsection (3) is amended by striking out the word "Minister" and substituting the words "Lieutenant Governor in Council".

4. Section 4, subsection (2) is amended by striking out the word "Minister" and by substituting the words "Lieutenant Governor in Council".

5. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Act will amend chapter 45 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1971.

2. Section 2, (2) and (6) presently read:

(2) The Commission shall consist of the following members, namely,

- (a) a chairman appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council,
- (b) the chairman of The Alberta Health Care Insurance Commission,
- (b1) the Director of Mental Health Services,
- (c) a Commissioner for Finance appointed by the Minister,
- (d) a Commissioner for Hospitals appointed by the Minister, and
- (e) six other persons appointed by the Minister.

(6) The members appointed by the Minister pursuant to subsection (2), clause (e) may include one or more members of the Legislative Assembly and a mem-ber of the Legislative Assembly so appointed is not ineligible to be a member of the Legislative Assembly or to sit or vote in the Legislative Assembly by reason only of holding the office of a member of the Commission or receiving payment for travelling and living expenses as a member of the Commission pur-suant to section 4, subsection (3).

3. Section 3 (3) presently reads:

(3) Where the Minister appoints a member pursuant to section 2, subsection (2), clause (e), he shall also prescribe the term of office for that member not exceeding three years and, subject to subsection (4), a member so appointed is eligible for re-appointment.

4. Section 4 (2) presently reads:

(2) The Minister shall prescribe the rates of salary to be paid to the Commissioner for Finance and the Commissioner for Hospitals and the rates of remuneration to be paid to the members of the Commission appointed pursuant to section 2, subsection (2), clause (e).
