## THE NORTHERN ALBERTA DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL AMENDMENT ACT, 1975

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1975)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Northern Alberta Development Council Act is hereby amended.*

2. *Section 4 is struck out and the following section substituted:*

4. The functions of the Council are to investigate, monitor, evaluate, plan and promote practical measures to foster and advance general development in northern Alberta, and to advise the Government thereon, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Council may investigate the requirements of the people resident in northern Alberta and make recommendations thereon in respect of

- (a) social and economic development,
- (b) development of communities and service delivery, and
- (c) development of government services and programs.

3. *Section 5 is struck out and the following section substituted:*

5. The Council shall be composed of not less than eight and not more than 10 members appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, one of whom shall be designated as chairman.

4. *Section 7 is amended by striking out the words "and employ expert consultants as it thinks necessary".*

5. *Section 8 is amended by striking out subsection (2).*

6. *The Northern Development Act is repealed.*

7. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

## Explanatory Notes

**1.** This Bill will amend chapter 259 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

**2.** Section 4 presently reads:

4. The functions of the Council are to investigate, plan, promote and co-ordinate practical measures to foster and advance development in northern Alberta and to advise the Government thereon, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing may investigate and recommend on the requirements of the area in the matter of

- (a) industrial development,
- (b) transportation facilities,
- (c) agricultural stabilization,
- (d) metis rehabilitation,
- (e) educational facilities, and
- (f) local administration.

**3.** Section 5 presently reads:

5. The Council shall be composed of not more than eight members to be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council and may include elected members of the Legislative Assembly.

**4.** Section 7 presently reads:

7. For the purpose of carrying out its functions the Council may hold public meetings and employ expert consultants as it thinks necessary.

**5.** Section 8, subsection (2) presently reads:

(2) Payment of a salary and expenses under this section to a member of the Council who is a member of the Legislative Assembly is not deemed to contravene the provisions of The Legislative Assembly Act respecting eligibility.

**6.** Repeals chapter 81 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1971.
