THE SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT AMENDMENT ACT, 1975 (No. 2)

(Assented to _____, 1975)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Social Development Act is hereby amended.*

2. *Section 29 is struck out and the following section is substituted therefor:*

29. Effective January 1, 1976 the amount of family allowance payable in each month in respect of a child who has a parent who is resident in Alberta shall be at the following rates based on the age of the child on the last day of the month:

- (a) for a child who has not attained seven years of age, \$18.40;
- (b) for a child who has attained seven years of age but has not attained 12 years of age, \$23.30;
- (c) for a child who has attained 12 years of age but has not attained 16 years of age, \$30.60;
- (d) for a child who has attained 16 years of age but has not attained 18 years of age, \$34.30.

3. *This Act comes into force on January 1, 1976.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend chapter 345 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. Section 29 presently reads:

29. Effective January 1, 1975, the amount of family allowance payable in each month in respect of a child who has a parent who is resident in Alberta shall be at the following rates based on the age of the child on the last day of the month:

- (a) for a child who has not attained seven years of age, \$16.40;
- (b) for a child who has attained seven years of age but has not attained 12 years of age, \$20.80;
- (c) for a child who has attained 12 years of age but has not attained 16 years of age, \$27.30;
- (d) for a child who has attained 16 years of age but has not attained 18 years of age, \$30.60.
