### **THE ALBERTA GOVERNMENT TELEPHONES AMENDMENT ACT**

*(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1975)*

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

*1. The Alberta Government Telephones Act is hereby amended.*

*2. Section 31 is re-numbered as subsection (1) of section 31.*

*3. The following subsection is added to section 31:*

(2) A person who makes an unsolicited telephone call for the purpose of selling a good or service before the hour of 9:00 a.m. or after the hour of 5:00 p.m. on any day or at any time on a Sunday or a public holiday is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than \$100 or to imprisonment for not more than six months.

*4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*
