THE AMUSEMENTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1975

(Assented to _____, 1975)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Amusements Act is hereby amended.*
- 2. The following section is added after section 28:*

28.1 (1) The owner or operator of every place of amusement which shows films on more than ninety days in a year shall submit to the Minister within thirty days of the end of each year a report showing the title of each film shown during the year, the number of times it was shown and whether such film was classed by the censor or board of censors as being suitable for family viewing.

(2) The Minister shall cause to be suspended, for a period of not less than three months, the licence of any place of amusement that shows films where

- (a) the owner or operator of the place of amusement fails to submit a report to the Minister as required by subsection (1), or
- (b) the report required by subsection (1) reveals that for the year covered by the report, the place of amusement has shown films in such a way that the number of showings of films which have been rated by the censor or board of censors as being suitable for family viewing is less than sixty per cent of the total of all showings of all films in the year.

3. Section 23 is amended by adding after clause (b) the following words: "or, (c) who fails to submit to the Minister the report required by subsection (1) of section 28.1."

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
