THE PROVINCIAL PARKS AMENDMENT ACT, 1975

, 1975)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Provincial Parks Act, 1974 is hereby amended.
- 2. Section 9 is amended by adding the following subsections after subsection (4):
- (5) In this section, "Alberta Senior Citizen" means a person who
 - (i) is receiving a pension and a supplement under the Old Age Security Act (Canada), and
 - (ii) is a resident of Alberta and has been for a period of at least twelve months.
- (6) Notwithstanding section 9, subsection (1) or any regulation issued pursuant thereto, any Alberta Senior Citizen may obtain, for himself or herself and his or her spouse
 - (i) access to any park designated as a provincial park, and
 - (ii) the use of one tent or trailer space and water, sewer and electrical services thereto, when available, in any such park

free of any fee or charge, providing he or she presents proof that he or she is an Alberta Senior Citizen upon entry into the park.

- 3. The initiation and duration of the rights established in section 2 shall be contingent upon the appropriation of funds therefor by separate vote of the Assembly.
- 4. This Act comes into force on a day to be fixed by proclamation which shall not be earlier than the effective date of the appropriation referred to in section 3.
