THE ALBERTA SCHOOL TRUSTEES' ASSOCIATION AMENDMENT ACT, 1976

(Assented to _____, 1976)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Alberta School Trustees' Association Act is hereby amended.*

2. *Section 4, subsection (1) is amended by striking out the word "and" at the end of clause (a), by adding the word ", and" at the end of clause (b) and by adding the following clause:*

(c) *may acquire by gift, purchase or otherwise, and may sell, exchange, mortgage, lease or otherwise dispose of, real and personal property.*

3. *Section 7 is amended by striking out subsection (3).*

4. *Section 9 is amended*

(a) *by renumbering the section as subsection (1),*

(b) *as to renumbered subsection (1), clause (a), sub-clause (ii) by striking out the words "divisional associations, zone branches" and by substituting the word "zones" ,*

(c) *as to renumbered subsection (1), clause (a), sub-clause (vi) by striking out the words "or in the case of delegates from a divisional association, by the board of that division", and*

(d) *by adding the following subsection:*

(2) *The Regulations Act does not apply to by-laws of the association made under subsection (1).*

5. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend chapter 332 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. Association may own and deal with real and personal property.

3. Section 7, subsection (3) presently reads:

(3) Each divisional school trustees' association in the Province is eligible for membership in the association.

4. Section 9, clause (a), subclauses (ii) and (vi) presently read:

9. The association in general meeting

(a) may pass by-laws, not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act or of any Act or regulation of the Province, respecting

(ii) the formation, regulation, management and dissolution of divisional associations, zone branches, and other sections or divisions of the association, and providing for the delegation to them of such powers as it may think fit, including the power to pass by-laws and rules for the management and regulation of their own business,

(vi) the fixing of annual and other fees payable by the members of the association or in the case of delegates from a divisional association, by the board of that division,
