THE CANCER TREATMENT AND PREVENTION AMENDMENT ACT, 1976

(Assented to _____, 1976)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Cancer Treatment and Prevention Act is hereby amended.

2. Section 12 is amended by adding after subsection (2) the following:

(3) The board may, with the approval of the Commission, provide for the manufacture, purchase or sale of pharmaceuticals or radio-pharmaceuticals for use in any hospital as defined by *The Alberta Hospitals Act*.

3. Section 15 is amended by striking out the words "a schedule of salaries to be paid to persons employed by the board, and".

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. The Provincial Cancer Hospitals Board to have the power to provide for the manufacture, purchase or sale of pharmaceuticals or radio-pharmaceuticals.

3. Section 15 presently reads:

15. The Commission may fix, from time to time, a schedule of salaries to be paid to persons employed by the board, and a schedule of approved charges for treatment and care provided to patients in hospitals and to persons attending at out-patient clinics.

Salaries for employees of the Provincial Cancer Hospitals Board are negotiated between the Board and the employees bargaining agent.
