THE LLOYDMINSTER HOSPITAL AMENDMENT ACT, 1976

(Assented to

, 1976)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Lloydminster Hospital Act is hereby amended.

2. Section 22 is struck out and the following substituted:

22. The Minister may prescribe a maximum rate of interest that a debenture may carry and no debenture shall be issued that carries interest at a rate in excess of the rate so prescribed.

3. The Schedule is amended as to Form A by striking out the words "at not more than six per cent per annum" wherever they occur and substituting the words "at not more than per cent per annum".

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Bill will amend chapter 19 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1948.
- 2. Section 22 presently reads:

22. Debentures shall not carry interest at a greater rate than six per cent per annum.

This amendment will allow for market fluctuations in interest rates for debentures.
