THE TRADE SCHOOLS REGULATION AMENDMENT ACT, 1977

(Assented to , 1977)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Trade Schools Regulation Act is hereby amended.

2. Section 15, subsection (1) is amended by striking out the word "three" and substituting the word "five".

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend chapter 366 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2. Section 15, subsection (1) presently reads:

15. (1) The Minister may appoint an advisory board of not more than three persons, one of whom shall be chairman, for the purpose of advising the Minister on any matter respecting the administration of this Act.
