THE ALBERTA EMBLEMS AMENDMENT ACT, 1977

(Assented to , 1977)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Alberta Emblems Act is hereby amended.
- 2. The following headings and sections are added after section 8:

Bird of Alberta

9. The bird known scientifically as *Bubo virginianus* and commonly known as the "great horned owl" is hereby adopted as the official bird of Alberta.

Stone of Alberta

- 10. The substance known scientifically as silicified wood and commonly known as "petrified wood" is hereby adopted as the official stone of Alberta.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- **1.** This Bill will amend chapter 11 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.
- 2. This amendment will add a bird and a stone to the present list of official emblems of Alberta.
