THE INDUSTRIAL WAGES SECURITY AMENDMENT ACT, 1977

(Assented to 1977)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Industrial Wages Security Act is amended by this Act.*
- 2 Section 4 is repealed.*

- 3 This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1 This Bill will amend chapter 184 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.

2 Section 4 presently reads:

4(1) Every employer shall, not later than the fifteenth day and the last day of each month make a return to the Minister in such form as the Minister may from time to time prescribe, setting out whether or not the wages payable to workmen employed by him on the last preceding pay day have or have not been paid in full, and in case the wages have not been so paid, the amount of the wages that were not then paid.

(2) Every employer who makes default in making any return that he is required by this section to make, is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than one hundred dollars and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term of not more than thirty days.
