### THE TEMPORARY ANTI-INFLATION MEASURES AMENDMENT ACT, 1977

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1977)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

*1 The Temporary Anti-Inflation Measures Act is amended by this Act.*

*2 Section 2 is amended by renumbering it as 2(1) and by adding the following subsections:*

(2) An award made before the commencement of this subsection pursuant to a procedure established by the Minister of Labour under section 163 of *The Alberta Labour Act, 1973* operates notwithstanding any agreement entered into pursuant to subsection (1).

(3) An agreement or a collective agreement

(a) to which registered nurses or graduate nurses or both are a party or which affects registered nurses or graduate nurses or both, and

(b) which incorporates or is based upon, in whole or in part, an award referred to in subsection (2),

operates, with respect to those registered nurses and graduate nurses, notwithstanding any agreement entered into pursuant to subsection (1).

*3 This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

## Explanatory Notes

**1** This Bill will amend chapter 83 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1975 (Second Session).

**2** Section 2 now reads:

*2. The Minister may, on behalf of the Government of Alberta and with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, enter into any agreement with the Government of Canada authorized by the federal Act.*

Section 163 of The Alberta Labour Act, 1973 allows the Lieutenant Governor in Council to order in emergency circumstances that a labour dispute be settled by procedures established by the Minister of Labour.
