AN ACT TO AMEND THE JUVENILE COURT ACT

(Assented to , 1977)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Juvenile Court Act is hereby amended.

2. In this Act.

- (a) "child" has the meaning ascribed to it in The Juvenile Delinquents Act (Canada);
- (b) "juvenile delinquent" has the meaning ascribed to it in The Juvenile Delinquents Act (Canada).

3. The following section is added after section 5.

"5.1 Where a child commits an offence and is adjudged by the Court to be a juvenile delinquent, the judge in addition to or as a condition of any other order he is empowered to make, may

- (a) order the child to make restitution by the performance of work or services to any person who has suffered injury or loss as a result of the commission of the offence by the child, or
- (b) order the child to perform work or services for the benefit of the community, or
- (c) make an order under both clause (a) and (b).

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
