AN ACT TO AMEND THE TEMPORARY ANTI-INFLATION MEASURES ACT

(Assented to _____, 1977)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Temporary Anti-Inflation Measures Act is hereby amended.*

2. *The following section is added after section 2:*

2.1 (1) Notwithstanding *The Public Utilities Board Act*, the Public Utilities Board shall apply such guidelines for the restraint of prices and profit margins as are issued pursuant to *The Anti-Inflation Act* (Canada), to any public utility rate fixed by the Board after the commencement of this section.

(2) The Public Utilities Board shall require every owner of a public utility to refund to each of its customers the difference between the sums paid to it by the customer, and the sums which would have been paid to it by that customer had all guidelines issued for the restraint of price and profit margins been applied from time to time to the rates charged by the owner of the public utility from October 14, 1975.

3. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*
