AN ACT TO AMEND THE ENVIRONMENT CONSERVATION ACT

(Assented to _____, 1977)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Environment Conservation Act is amended by this Act.*
2. *Section 7(1) is amended*
 - (a) *by repealing clause (b) and substituting the following:*
 - (b) *may, from time to time and as it considers appropriate, inquire into any matter pertaining to environment conservation and make its recommendation and report thereon to the Minister;*
 - and*
 - (b) *as to clause (h) by striking out the words with the approval of the Minister.*
3. *Section 8(1) is amended by striking out Subject to the approval of the Minister, the Authority and substituting The Authority.*
4. *Section 11 is amended by striking out , after consultation with the Minister.*
5. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

General

This Bill will remove the need for prior approval or consultation with the Minister with respect to certain activities of the Authority.

1. This Bill will amend chapter 125 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970.

2. Replaces section 7(1)(b).

3. Amends section 8(1).

4. Amends section 11.
