AN ACT TO AMEND THE MARKETING OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS ACT

(Assented to _____, 1977)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

*1. The Marketing of Agricultural Products Act is
amended by this Act.*

*2. In the following provisions poultry and eggs and
poultry and egg products is struck out wherever it occurs
and hogs, poultry and eggs and hog, poultry and egg
products is substituted*

section 10(1) (a) (i1)

section 10(1) (a) (iv1)

*3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is
assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. Amends R.S.A. 1970, c. 225.

2. Amends section 10(1)(a) to enable the Alberta Agricultural Products Marketing Council to empower the Alberta Hog Producers' Marketing Board to control the marketing of hogs and, where necessary to withhold hogs from market.
