### **AN ACT TO AMEND THE INDIVIDUAL'S RIGHTS PROTECTION ACT**

*(Assented to , 1977)*

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of  
the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

*1. The Individual's Rights Protection Act is amended by  
this Act.*

*2. Section 28(a) is repealed and the following is substituted:*

*(a) "age" means any age of 45 years or more;*

*3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is  
assented to.*
