AN ACT TO AMEND THE INDIVIDUAL'S RIGHTS PROTECTION ACT

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Individual's Rights Protection Act is amended by this Act.
- 2. Section 28(a) is repealed and the following is substituted:
 - (a) "age" means any age of 45 years or more;
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
