#### THE APPROPRIATION (ALBERTA HERITAGE SAVINGS TRUST FUND, CAPITAL PROJECTS DIVISION) SUPPLEMENTARY ACT, 1978

(Assented to , 1978)

#### MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN:

WHEREAS it appears by a Message from His Honour, Ralph G. Steinhauer, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the Message, that the sums hereinafter mentioned not otherwise provided for are required during the fiscal year ending March 31, 1979 for the purpose of the making of investments pursuant to section 6(1) (a) of *The Alberta Heritage Savings Trust Fund Act* in projects which will provide long term economic or social benefits to the people of Alberta but which will not by their nature yield a return to the Alberta Heritage Savings Trust Fund.

MAY IT THEREFORE PLEASE YOUR MAJESTY that it be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, as follows:

1 From and out of the Alberta Heritage Savings Trust Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole \$4 816 000 for the period from April 1, 1978 to March 31, 1979 for the purpose of making investments not otherwise provided for in projects which will provide long term social and economic benefits to the people of Alberta but which will not by their nature yield a return to that Fund being the amount of the supplementary votes by project set forth in the Schedule to this Act.

**2** The due application of all money expended under this Act shall be accounted for.

**3** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
