AN ACT TO AMEND THE JUVENILE COURT ACT

(Assented to _____, 1978)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Juvenile Court Act is amended by this Act.*

2. *The following is added after section 14:*

14.1 Notwithstanding section 14, upon the sentencing of a juvenile delinquent for an offence, the clerk shall send by registered mail the name and address of the juvenile delinquent and a transcript of the sentence to every person that the record shows as having suffered personal injury or loss of or damage to property as a result of the offence committed.

3. *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend chapter 195 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970.

2. Name, address and sentence to be sent to persons who have suffered injury or damage.
