AN ACT TO AMEND THE ALBERTA HISTORICAL RESOURCES ACT

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Alberta Historical Resources Act is amended by this Act.
- 2. Section 1 is amended in clause (h) by adding at the end thereof

and all or any of the lands surrounding or in the vicinity of the historical resource which relate to the interest, appreciation or enjoyment of the historical resource.

3. This Act comes into force on the date upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Bill will amend chapter 5 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1973.
- 2. Amends section 1 to permit acquisition of lands surrounding an historic resource.
