**AN ACT TO REPEAL
THE HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUMS ACT**

(Assented to _____, 1978)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Health Insurance Premiums Act is repealed.*
2. This Act comes into force on a date to be fixed by Proclamation which shall be conditional upon and not earlier than the effective date of an appropriation by the Legislature of money to the purposes set out in *The Alberta Health Care Insurance Act* to replace money previously collected under *The Health Insurance Premiums Act*.

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will repeal chapter 167 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970.
