# 1978

#### THE CROWN CORPORATION REPORTING ACT

#### (Assented to , 1978)

**H**<sup>ER</sup> MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** In this Act

- (a) "Committee" means the Select Standing Committee of the Legislative Assembly on Crown Corporations;
- (b) "Corporation" means a Crown corporation named in the Schedule.

2. (1) Where a Corporation is required by statute to submit an annual report to be tabled in the Legislative Assembly the report shall be deemed to be referred to the Committee upon being so tabled.

(2) A Corporation that is not required to submit its annual report to be tabled in the Legislative Assembly by any other Act shall prepare a report on its transactions in respect of each fiscal year and submit it to the Provincial Treasurer not later than 30 days after it is completed and the Provincial Treasurer shall table it in the Legislative Assembly forthwith or, if the Assembly be not then sitting within 15 days of the commencement of the next sitting and upon being so tabled it shall be deemed to be referred to the Committee.

**3.** (1) For the purposes of this Act a Committee appointed by the Legislative Assembly shall be deemed to continue after prorogation of that Legislative Assembly until another Committee is appointed by the Legislative Assembly or the Legislative Assembly is dissolved.

(2) In carrying out their duties under this Act during the time that a Committee is deemed to continue pursuant to subsection (1), each member of the Committee has the privileges and protection of a member of the Legislative Assembly in proceedings of a committee of the Legislative Assembly and *The Legislative Assembly Act* applies to the Committee and to its members during such time.

4. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
