AN ACT TO AMEND THE ELECTION ACT

, 1978)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Election Act is amended by this Act.
- 2. The following is added after section 160:
- 160.1 (1) The election expenses incurred by or on behalf of a registered candidate, including payments in respect of his personal expenses, and the registered constituency association of the party that endorses the candidate in the electoral division in which he is a candidate, shall not exceed \$1 for each elector whose name appears on an official list of electors for a polling subdivision in the electoral division for the election or the next preceding election in that electoral division, whichever number is the larger.
- (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the election expenses incurred by or on behalf of a registered political party, its registered constituency associations and the registered candidates it endorses shall not in aggregate exceed \$1 for each elector whose name appears on an official list of electors for the election or the next preceding election whichever number is the larger.
- 3. This Act comes into force on a date to be fixed by Proclamation.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Bill will amend chapter 117 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970.
- ${\bf 2.}$ Adds new section 160.1. Places limit on election expenses of \$1 per elector.
