AN ACT TO AMEND THE ELECTIONS ACT (No. 2)

, 1978)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Elections Act is amended by this Act.
- 2. The following is added after section 163:
- 163.1 Where the Lieutenant Governor in Council receives a petition signed by no less than 10% of the electors of the Province requesting that a plebiscite be conducted on a question or or questions regarding the desirability of
 - (a) amending existing legislation, or
 - (b) introducing new legislation,
- relative to any subject matter whatsoever within the legislative jurisdiction of the Province, the Lieutenant Governor in Council shall give directions for the holding of a general plebiscite of the electors of the Province to determine the question or questions contained in the plebiscite.
- **163.2** A plebiscite resulting from a petition under section 163.1 shall be held within 90 days of the date of receipt of the petition by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Bill will amend chapter 117 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970.
- 2. Adds new section 163.1. Makes the holding of a plebiscite obligatory when petitioned for by 10% of votes.
