**AN ACT TO AMEND THE ELECTION FINANCES  
AND CONTRIBUTIONS DISCLOSURE ACT**

*(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1978)*

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

*1. The Election Finances and Contributions Disclosure Act is  
amended by this Act.*

*2. The following is added after section 27:*

**27.1** (1) In this section, "Crown corporation" means a body  
corporate in which the Government of Alberta has a shareholding  
interest, or an agent of the Crown.

(2) No person who is a director of a Crown corporation may  
solicit or accept a contribution.

(3) Every person who contravenes this section is guilty of an  
offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more  
than \$10 000.

*3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is as-  
sented to.*

## **Explanatory Notes**

- 1.** This Bill will amend chapter 18 of the Alberta Statutes, 1977.
- 2.** Adds new section 27.1. Provides that a director of a Crown corporation may not solicit or accept a contribution.
