### **AN ACT TO INCORPORATE FIRST WESTERN TRUST COMPANY**

*(Assented to , 1978)*

**Preamble**

WHEREAS the persons hereinafter named have by their petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition:

NOW THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**Short  
Title**

**1.** This Act may be cited as *The First Western Trust Company Act*.

**Incorporation**

**2.** R. W. Chapman, businessman, R. W. Nickerson, retired, J. F. Fendall, businessman, W. A. Cochrane, university president, and E. G. Robinson, businessman together with such persons as become shareholders in the company, are incorporated under the name of First Western Trust Company, hereinafter called "the Company".

**Provisional  
Directors**

**3.** The persons named in section 2 shall be the provisional directors of the Company.

**Capital  
Stock**

**4.** The capital stock of the company shall be \$10 000 000 divided into 1 000 000 shares of \$10 each.

**Head  
Office**

**5.** The head office of the Company shall be in the City of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta.

**Application  
of the Trust  
Companies  
Act**

**6.** The Company has all the powers, privileges and immunities conferred on a trust company by, and is subject to all the limitations, liabilities and provisions of *The Trust Companies Act*.

**Commence-  
ment**

**7.** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
