## THE GLENBOW-ALBERTA INSTITUTE AMENDMENT ACT, 1979

(Assented to , 1979)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Glenbow-Alberta Institute Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 5(3) is amended by striking out "The members of the Board of Governors shall not receive any remuneration for their services but the Institute" and substituting "The Institute may pay the members of the Board of Governors remuneration for their services and".
- 3 This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

#### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter 35 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1966.
- **2** Section 5(3) presently reads:

(3) The members of the Board of Governors shall not receive any remuneration for their services but the Institute may compensate them for reasonable travelling and other expenses incurred while absent from their ordinary place of residence and in the course of their duties as members of the Board.

This amendment permits the Institute to remunerate members of the Board of Governors for their services.
