AN ACT TO AMEND THE BLIND PERSONS' GUIDE DOGS ACT

(Assented to

, 1979)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Blind Persons' Guide Dogs Act is amended by this Act.
- 2. Section 2 is amended by adding the following after subsection (2):
- (2.1) No person, directly or indirectly, alone or with another, by himself or by the interposition of another, shall
 - (a) refuse to employ or refuse to continue to employ any person, or
 - (b) discriminate against any person with regard to employment or any term or condition of employment,

for the reason that he is a blind person accompanied by a guide dog.

3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assened to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This bill will amend chapter 58 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1977.
- 2. Adds a new subsection 2(2.1) which forbids discrimination in employment on the grounds of being accompanied by a guide dog.
