**AN ACT TO AMEND
THE INDIVIDUAL'S RIGHTS PROTECTION ACT**

(Assented to _____, 1979)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows.

- 1. The Individual's Rights Protection Act is amended by this Act.*
- 2. Section 28(a) is repealed and the following is substituted:*
 - (a) "age" means any age of 45 years or more;*
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill amends chapter 2 of the Statutes of Alberta 1972.

2. Amends section 28; prevents discrimination against persons of 65 years or more on grounds of age.

Section 28(a) presently reads:

“(a) “age” means any age of 45 years or more and less than 65 years;”
