THE COMMISSIONERS FOR OATHS AMENDMENT ACT, 1980

(Assented to _____, 1980)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 *The Commissioners for Oaths Act is amended by this Act.*

2 *The following is added after section 9:*

10(1) No person shall

(a) administer an oath, or

(b) take or receive an affidavit, declaration or
affirmation,

unless he is empowered to do so by this Act.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to

(a) the administering of an oath or the taking or
receiving of an affidavit, declaration or affirmation by a
person who is empowered to do so by any other law in
force in Alberta, or

(b) the administering of an oath or the taking or
receiving of an affidavit, declaration or affirmation in
Alberta for use only in another jurisdiction by a person
who is empowered to do so by the laws of that other
jurisdiction.

11 A person who contravenes this Act is guilty of an
offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not
more than \$500.

3 *This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented
to.*
