THE DEFAMATION AMENDMENT ACT, 1980

(Assented to , 1980)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Defamation Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 The following is added after section 9:
 - **9.1**(1) If a defendant published an opinion expressed by another person, other than an employee or agent of the defendant, that is alleged to be defamatory, a defence of fair comment shall not fail by reason only that the defendant did not hold that opinion.
 - (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the defence of fair comment is not available to a defendant if it is proved that he acted maliciously in making the publication.
- 3 This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter 87 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.
- **2** Permits the use of the defence of fair comment in certain circumstances.
