#### THE RECIPROCAL ENFORCEMENT OF MAINTENANCE ORDERS AMENDMENT ACT, 1980

(Assented to , 1980)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The Reciprocal Enforcement of Maintenance Orders Act, 1980 is amended by this Act.

2 Section 3(3)(b) is repealed and the following is substituted:

(b) a certified transcript of the evidence given in the proceeding or a sworn document setting out or summarizing the evidence given in the proceeding,

**3** This Act comes into force on a date or dates to be fixed by **Proclamation**.

### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter 44 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1980.
- **2** Section 3(3) presently reads in part:

(3) If a provisional order is made, a proper officer of the court in Alberta shall send to the Attorney General for transmission to a reciprocating state

(b) a sworn document setting out or summarizing the evidence given in the proceeding,
