AN ACT TO AMEND THE SCHOOL ACT

(Assented to _____, 1980)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The School Act is amended by this Act.*
2. *Section 84 is repealed and the following is substituted:*

84. (1) When a matter is appealed to the Minister pursuant to section 85(1) the Minister shall establish a Board of Reference to hear the appeal.

(2) The Board of Reference shall consist of

- (a) one person nominated by the board in question;
- (b) one person nominated by the local of the Alberta Teachers' Association of which the teacher is a member; and
- (c) a chairman, who shall be nominated by the two persons appointed under (a) and (b) or if they do not agree upon a chairman within five days, then by the Minister.

(3) The decision of a Board of Reference shall be final and binding on both parties to the disagreement.

(4) The members of a Board of Reference shall receive such remuneration and expenses as the Lieutenant Governor in Council determines.

3. *Section 85(1) is amended by striking out "the Board" and substituting "a Board".*

4. *This Act comes into force on a date to be fixed by Proclamation.*

Explanatory Notes

1. This Bill will amend chapter 329, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970.

2. Provides for the Minister to appoint a Board of Reference to determine each appeal and specifies the membership of a Board. Section 84 presently reads:

84. (1) The Lieutenant Governor in Council shall appoint a Board of Reference consisting of not more than nine persons.

(2) The members of the Board of Reference shall receive such remuneration and expenses as the Lieutenant Governor in Council determines.

3. Section 85(1) presently reads:

85. (1) Where a disagreement arises between a board and a teacher with respect

(a) to a termination of a contract of employment, or

(b) to a termination of a designation, or

(c) to the refusal of a board to give an approval pursuant to section 80, subsection (2),

a board or a teacher, may appeal to the Minister who shall refer the appeal to the Board of Reference.
