AN ACT TO AMEND THE HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT, 1975

(Assented to , 1980)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Highway Traffic Act, 1975, is amended by this Act.

2. The following section is added after section 106.

106.1 (1) No person shall drive a vehicle upon a highway unless every person in the vehicle under the age of 18 years is secured in his seat by a seat belt or restraint device.

(2) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may issue regulations prescribing the equipment that shall qualify as a seat belt or restraint device for the purpose of subsection (1).

(3) Any person who contravenes this section or the regulations is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of up to \$50.

3. This Act comes into force on the date to be fixed by Proclamation.

Explanatory Notes

- 1.** This Bill will amend chapter 56 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1975(2).
- 2.** New section which forbids operation of a vehicle unless minors are wearing seat belts; provision for regulation to define seat belts; offences and penalties.
