AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHILD WELFARE ACT

(Assented to , 1980)

- 1. The Child Welfare Act is amended by this Act.
- 2. Section 17 is amended
 - (a) by striking out "medical, surgical and psychiatric care" wherever it occurs and substituting "medical, surgical, psychiatric and psychological care", and
 - (b) by adding after subsection (1)
 - (1.1) Medical, surgical, psychiatric, and psychological care are not to be administered to a child who is in the care of the Director of Child Welfare unless he or his agent authorizes that care.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

- 1. This Bill will amend Chapter 45 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970.
- 2. Section 17 presently reads:
 - 17(1) During the time a child is detained in custody pursuant to section 16 the authority who apprehended the child,
 - (a) is responsible for his care, maintenance and well being, and
 - (b) may authorize the provision of such medical, surgical and psychiatric care as the authority considers necessary, without the consent of the parent or guardian and without an order of a court.
 - (2) No liability attaches to the authority or to a duly qualified medical practitioner or to a hospital by reason only that a child is provided with medical, surgical or psychiatric care as mentioned in subsection (1).
