AN ACT TO AMEND THE INDIVIDUAL'S RIGHTS PROTECTION ACT (No. 2)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The Individuals Rights Protection Act is amended by this Act.

2 The following is added after section 1(2):

(3) In this Act, "place of origin" means a country or group of countries, or any region, political division or municipality of a country, where a person was born or has at any time resided.

3 This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.

Explanatory Notes

General: This Bill will provide a definition of "place of origin" to make it apply to political sub-divisions, geographic regions and municipalities and thus increase the scope of protection against discrimination offered by this Act.

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter 2 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1972.
- 2 Amends section 1 to add a definition.
