### THE LIVESTOCK BRAND INSPECTION AMENDMENT ACT, 1981

(Assented to , 1981)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Livestock Brand Inspection Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section !1 is amended by renumbering it as section 11(1) and by adding the following after subsection (1):
  - (2) A person who, pursuant to subsection (1), collects an inspection fee may receive a commission in accordance with the regulations.
- 3 Section 51 is amended by adding the following after clause (a):
  - (a.1) governing commissions for the collection of inspection fees,

In accordance with section 4(1) of The Interpretation Act, 1980, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.

#### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter 63 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1971.
- 2 Section 11 presently reads:
  - 11 Where livestock is delivered to any place where a sale transaction has been conducted and brand inspection is required, the person in charge of the sale shall collect from the consignor the prescribed inspection fee for each head of livestock inspected and shall pay the fee to the Minister when requested to do so by an inspector.
- **3** Section 51 presently reads:
  - 51 The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations
    - (a) fixing inspection fees,
    - (b) fixing licence fees,
    - (b1) governing the issuance and cancellation of permits and licences authorized by this Act,
    - (c) prescribing forms,
    - (d) prescribing returns to be made, and
    - (e) providing for all other matters necessary to carry into effect the provisions of this Act.
