THE SENIOR CITIZENS BENEFITS AMENDMENT ACT, 1981

(Assented to , 1981)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Senior Citizens Benefits Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 2(1) is repealed and the following is substituted:
 - **2**(1) In accordance with the regulations the Minister may, out of money voted by the Legislature for the purpose, pay benefits in those amounts that may be prescribed by the regulations to every person who is a resident of Alberta and who
 - (a) is receiving a pension and a supplement, or
 - (b) is over the age of 60 and under the age of 65 and is receiving a spouse's allowance under section 17.31 of the Old Age Security Act (Canada).

In accordance with section 4(1) of The Interpretation Act. 1980, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter 84 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1973.
- **2** Section 2(1) presently reads:
 - 2(1) In accordance with the regulations the Minister may, out of moneys appropriated by the Legislature for the purpose, pay benefits in such amounts as may be prescribed by the regulations to every person who
 - (a) is receiving a pension and a supplement, and
 - (b) is a resident of Alberta.
