## THE EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS AMENDMENT ACT, 1981

(Assented to , 1981)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Employment Standards Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 20 is amended
  - (a) in subsection (2)(b) by adding "or authorized by a collective agreement that is binding on the employee" after "employee";
  - (b) in subsection (3) by adding "or authorization in a collective agreement" after "authorization of an employee".

3 This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on March 1. 1981.

#### **Explanatory Notes**

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter 62 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1980.
- 2 Section 20(2) and (3) presently read:
  - (2) An employer may deduct from the wages, overtime pay or entitlements of an employee a sum of money that is
    - (a) permitted or required to be deducted by an Act or regulation or a judgment of a court, or
    - (b) subject to subsection (3), personally authorized in writing by the employee to be deducted.
  - (3) No written authorization of an employee permits an employer to deduct from the wages, overtime pay or entitlements of an employee a sum for
    - (a) faulty workmanship, or
    - (b) cash shortages or loss of property if an individual other than the employee has access to the cash or property.
