LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT ACT, 1981 (NO. 2)

(Assented to , 1981)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The Legislative Assembly Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 Section 51.2 is amended
 - (a) in subsection (2)
 - (i) in clause (a) by striking out "and equipment";
 - (ii) in clause (b) by striking out "and supplies";
 - (b) by adding the following after subsection (2):
 - (2.1) There may be provided to each member of the Legislative Assembly the office supplies and equipment necessary for the operation of the rental office space referred to in subsection (2).
 - (c) in subsection (6)(b) by striking out "and equipment" and by striking out ", supplies".

In accordance with section 4(1) of The Interpretation Act, 1980, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter 204 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1970.
- 2 Section 51.2 presently reads in part:
 - (2) There may be paid in respect of each member of the Legislative Assembly to enable him to perform his duties as a member in his constituency the actual cost of
 - (a) rental office space, including furnishings and equipment, and
 - (b) office and secretarial assistance and supplies and services required by the member in an aggregate amount of not more than \$10 000 a year.
 - (6) Nothing in this section
 - (b) affects the right of a member to have the Clerk enter into an agreement on his behalf under subsection (4) in respect of rental furnishings and equipment, secretarial assistance, supplies and services, or any of them, notwithstanding that there is no agreement in respect of rental office space for that member, or
