THE REMEMBRANCE DAY ACT

(Assented to _____, 1981)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Schools open

1(1) In a year when Remembrance Day falls upon a day which is not a Saturday or Sunday, notwithstanding *The School Act*, every school shall remain open.

(2) Where subsection (1) applies no instruction or school activity shall take place between 11:00 a.m. and 11:05 a.m. and the school shall either

(a) arrange for a non-denominational remembrance ceremony to be held at the school at 11:00 a.m., in which case every student shall either attend the ceremony or remain in the school, silent, during its duration, or

(b) ensure the observance of 2 minute's silence from 11:00 a.m. to 11:02 a.m.

No retail business

2 No retail business shall remain open on Remembrance Day except

(a) a retail business that has an area accessible to the public of less than 250 square metres, or

(b) has as its principle activity the supply of

(i) prepared meals,

(ii) fuel,

(iii) emergency repair services,

- (iv) medical, dental or veterinarian services,
- (v) accommodation,
- (vi) transportation or travel services.

- No liquor to be served** **3** Notwithstanding section 2, no retail business shall sell or serve liquor on Remembrance Day.
- Other Acts** **4** This Act operates notwithstanding any other Act.
- Offences and penalties** **5** Every person who contravenes a provision of this Act commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than \$500.
- Crown bound** **6** This Act binds the Crown.
- Coming into force** **7** This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
