THE EAU CLAIRE TRUST COMPANY ACT

(Assented to _____, 1981)

Preamble	<p>WHEREAS the persons hereinafter named have by their petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;</p> <p>HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:</p>
Definition	<p>1 In this Act, "Company" means the company incorporated by section 2.</p>
Incorporation	<p>2 Dr. Eliyahu Scheinberg, Jean F. Krieger, Janice E. Krieger, Lloyd K. Boswell and Marilyn Boswell, all of the City of Calgary, together with such persons as become shareholders in the Company, are incorporated as a body corporate under the name of Eau Claire Trust Company.</p>
Provisional directors	<p>3 The persons named in section 2 shall be the provisional directors of the Company.</p>
Capital stock	<p>4 The capital stock of the Company shall be \$10 000 000 consisting of 1 000 000 shares with a par value of \$10 each.</p>
Head office	<p>5 The head office of the Company shall be in the City of Calgary.</p>
Application of The Trust Companies Act	<p>6 The Company has all the powers, privileges and immunities referred on a trust company by, and is subject to all the limitations, liabilities and provisions of <i>The Trust Companies Act</i>.</p>
Coming into force	<p>7 This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.</p>
