THE RICHMOND GATE TRUST COMPANY ACT

	(Assented to , 1981)
Preamble	WHEREAS the persons hereinafter named have by their petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;
	THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:
Definitions	1 In this Act, "Company" means the company incorporated by section 2.
Incorporation	2 Colin Taylor, Larry T. Andrews, John F. Hunt, Robert B. Brint- nell and Kimberly Israel, all businessmen of the City of Edmonton, together with such persons as may become shareholders in the Com- pany, are incorporated as a body corporate under the name of Rich- mond Gate Trust Company.
Provisional directors	3 The persons named in section 2 shall be the provisional directors of the Company.
Capital stock	4 The capital stock of the Company shall be \$3 000 000 consisting of 300 000 shares with a par value of \$10.
Head office	5 The head office of the Company shall be in the City of Edmonton or such other place in the Province of Alberta as the directors may resolve.
Application of The Trust Companies Act	6 The Company has all the powers, privileges and immunities con- ferred on a trust company by, and is subject to all the limitations, liabilities and provisions of <i>The Trust Companies Act</i> .
Coming into force	7 This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
