LEGISLATIVE OFFICES STATUTES AMENDMENT ACT, 1982

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Election Act

- 1(1) The Election Act is amended by this section.
- (2) The following is added after section 6:
 - **6.1**(1) The Chief Electoral Officer shall submit annually to the Select Standing Committee an estimate of the sum that will be required to be provided by the Legislature for the payment of the salaries, allowances and expenses of the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer during the next ensuing fiscal year.
 - (2) The Select Standing Committee shall review each estimate submitted pursuant to subsection (1) and, on completion of the review, the chairman of the Committee shall submit the estimate to the Provincial Treasurer for inclusion in the estimates.

Ombudsman Act

- 2(1) The Ombudsman Act is amended by this section.
- (2) The following is added after section 10:
 - 10.1(1) The Ombudsman shall submit annually to the Select Standing Committee an estimate of the sum that will be required to be provided by the Legislature for the payment of the salaries, allowances and expenses of the Office of the Ombudsman during the next ensuing fiscal year.

Explanatory Notes

Election Act

- 1(1) This section will amend chapter E-2 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- (2) Financing of operations.

Ombudsman Act

- 2(1) This section will amend chapter O-7 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- (2) Financing of operations.

(2) The Select Standing Committee shall review each estimate submitted pursuant to subsection (1) and, on completion of the review, the chairman of the Committee shall submit the estimate to the Provincial Treasurer for inclusion in the estimates.

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.
