DEPARTMENT OF GOVERNMENT SERVICES AMENDMENT ACT, 1982

(Assented to _____, 1982)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 *The Department of Government Services Act is amended by this Act.*

2 *Section 7(3)(d) is amended by striking out "Auditor General" and substituting "Provincial Treasurer".*

3 *Section 13 is amended*

(a) by repealing subsection (2)(a) and substituting the following:

(a) acquire equipment, services and supplies that are necessary in order for the Minister to provide telecommunication services and data processing and computer services to any department,

(b) in subsection (3) by striking out "\$75 000 000" and substituting "\$150 000 000".

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.

Explanatory Notes

1 This Bill will amend chapter D-21 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.

2 Section 7(3) presently reads in part:

(3) There shall be a Committee to be known as the Public Records Committee which shall consist of

(d) a representative of the Auditor General, and

3 Section 13(2) presently reads in part:

(2) The Provincial Treasurer shall, on the requisition of the Minister, advance from and out of the General Revenue Fund to the revolving fund administered by the Minister any money that may be required from time to time by the Minister to

(a) acquire equipment, services and supplies that are necessary in order for the Minister to provide a data processing and computer service to any department,

Section 13(3) presently reads:

(3) The net amount outstanding at any time in respect of advances under subsection (2) shall not exceed \$75 000 000.
