REMEMBRANCE DAY ACT

(Assented to , 1982)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

School
remembrance
ceremony

1(1) On Remembrance Day no instruction or school activity shall take place between 11:00 a.m. and 11:05 a.m. in any school and the school shall either

(a) arrange for a non-denominational remembrance ceremony to be held at the school from 11:00 a.m. to 11:05 a.m. in which case every student shall either attend the ceremony or remain in the school, silent, during its duration, or

(b) ensure the observance of 2 minute's silence from 11:00 a.m. to 11:02 a.m.

(2) In a year when Remembrance Day falls on a day on which a school is not open, the provisions of subsection (1) shall apply to the day next preceeding Remembrance Day on which the school is open.

2 This Act binds the Crown.

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.
