AN ACT TO AMEND THE AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT ACT

(Assented to _____, 1982)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 The Agricultural Development Act is amended by this Act.

2 Section 1 is amended by adding the following after clause (a):

(a.1) "applicant" means a producer of agricultural products, owner of an associated business or an agricultural industry that makes an application for a loan or guarantee under this Act.

3 Section 13 is amended by renumbering it as subsection (1) and adding the following after the renumbered subsection (1):

(2) No applicant shall be required, as a condition of obtaining a loan or guarantee, to satisfy the Corporation that adequate financial assistance is not obtainable from any other source on reasonable terms and conditions.

*In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act,
this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal
Assent.*

Explanatory Notes

1 This Bill will amend chapter A-7 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.

2 Provides a new definition.

3 Provides that the Corporation may not demand evidence that conventional funding is not available.
