CANADIAN LUTHERAN BIBLE INSTITUTE AMENDMENT ACT, 1982

(Assented to _____, 1982)

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that *An Act to Incorporate The Canadian Lutheran Bible Institute*, being chapter 87 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1947, be amended as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petitioner;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1 An Act to Incorporate The Canadian Lutheran Bible Institute Act is amended by this Act.

2 The title is struck out and the following is substituted:

CANADIAN LUTHERAN BIBLE INSTITUTE ACT

3 Section 5 is amended

(a) by repealing subsection (2) and substituting:

(2) The Board of Trustees shall be members selected from congregations of The Lutheran Churches of Canada.

(2.1) Candidates for membership on the Board of Trustees shall be nominated by a nominating committee consisting of 3 members as prescribed in the constitution of the Institute, *and*

(b) subsection (3) is amended by striking out "president" and substituting "chairman" and by striking out "vice-president" and substituting "vice-chairman".

Explanatory Notes

1 This Bill will amend chapter 87 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1947.

2 Amends title.

2(a) Section 5(2) presently reads:

5(2) The said Board of Trustees shall as far as possible and consistent with the "All Lutheran" policy of the corporation be chosen equally from among the four synods: Augustana Synod, Lutheran Free Church, Norwegian Lutheran Church, and the United Danish Lutheran Church.

Canadidates for membership on the Board shall be placed in nomination by a Nominating Committee consisting of one member elected by the Board of Trustees presently serving at the date of the passing of this Act and two members shall be elected by the members of the corporation.

(b) Section 5(3) presently reads:

5(3) Thereupon after their election the Board of Trustees shall elect three officers, a president, vice-president and secretary, from their number and these three officers shall constitute the executive committee.

4 *The following is added after section 7:*

7.1 The Canadian Lutheran Bible Institute has the power to grant degrees in divinity.

5 *Section 8 is repealed and the following is substituted:*

8 All the real and personal property owned by the Canadian Lutheran Bible Institute in the City of Camrose, which is used for religious educational purposes or as residences of students and staff is exempt from all taxes, rates and assessments of every nature and kind, except local improvements and frontage tax.

In accordance with section 4(1) of the Interpretation Act, this Bill comes into force on the date it receives Royal Assent.

4 Establishes power to grant degrees in divinity.

5 Section 8 presently reads:

8. *All the real and personal property described as and situated upon,-*

All that portion of block thirteen (13) in the Townsite of Camrose, in the Province of Alberta, Dominion of Canada, of record in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District as plan XXVIII A.A., described as follows:

Commencing at the north-east corner of said block thirteen (13); thence westerly along the northern boundary thereof two hundred and sixty (260) feet; thence southerly and parallel and with the east boundary of the said block, two hundred (200) feet; thence easterly and parallel with the northern boundary aforesaid to the east boundary; thence northerly along the said east boundary to the point of commencement, containing one and twenty-hundredths (1.20) acres, more or less;

Together with any other buildings that may be constructed for academic purposes on said portion of block thirteen (13) plan XXVIII A.A., within the said Town of Camrose, if they be not, wholly or in part, private residential dwellings for a teacher or any other member of the staff; provided, however, that there shall always be rooms in the dormitory buildings for one male and one female teacher acting and supervising dean and preceptress, and for no other person not a bona fide student attending the Institution;

while used for the purpose of the Corporation shall be exempt from all taxes, rates, levies and assessments of every nature and kind, except local improvements and frontage tax.
